



MARCH WHITETAIL PROPERTY CHECKLIST

- ☐ **Trail Camera Pictures:** Survival, deer health, and predator presence.
- ☐ **Shed hunt:** If you're like us it turns into scouting, but keep an eye out for the antlers.
- ☐ Explore, scout, and walk the land in a different way noting final observations before green-up.
- ☐ **Trail Camera Tune-Up:** Bring them in for maintenance, but put out a few in random spots, you might learn something new.
- ☐ **Timber work:** Any type of cutting is fair game now. Temps above freezing mean it's time for hinge cuts as well.
- ☐ **Cutting propagation:** An effective means for transplanting some species - the wet soils of spring help make it a success.

Timber Stand Improvement: If you've followed the Forest Built for Deer posts, you will know what YOU want for your land.

☐

Frost Seeding: When the last of the snow is melting, get out there with the switchgrass, clover, and other seed that does well with this process.

☐

Soil Tests: Get them in now so you're not scrambling later.

☐

Lime: It's always the time to lime... but immediately following your soil test is a great time to get it done.

☐

Clearings: Get it done once the ground dries just a little and no new growth has started yet. It's 3X the effort after green up.

☐

Predator hunting or trapping: Even if it's something new to you - try it! It's fun and will help reduce the impact on your herd.

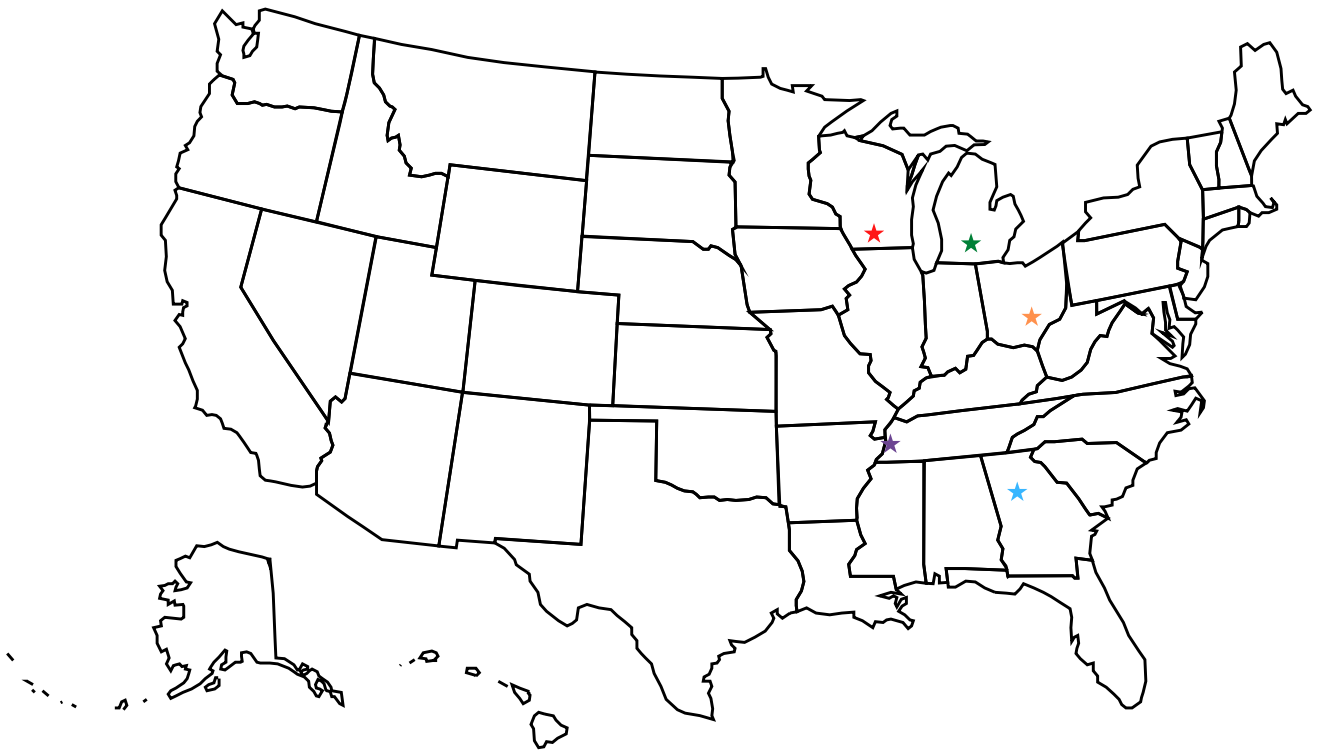
